

DRPOA September 18, 2001 Board Meeting Agenda

Meeting called to order 7:05 p.m.

1. Water commissioner, Roger Mlodzick, came into discuss the well depth issue. It is an issue for the augmentation plan because it is in a court decree. This makes it a technical and legal issue. It is not a physical issue because we are in fractured granite. Of 115 developments only 2 have any kind of a depth limitation – one up on Crow Hill is the other. He said they do not enforce this issue. He said he would come to a hearing to support the change if needed.
